

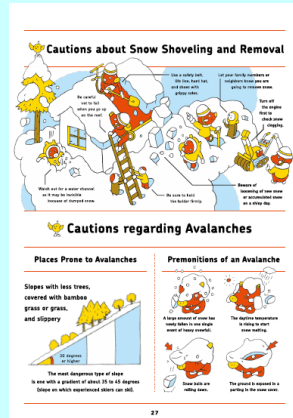
Sonafuku Note Manual

We created “Sonafuku Note,” an abbreviation of “Sonaeru Fukushima Note,” a Fukushima Prefecture disaster risk reduction (DRR) guide book on the necessity of “preparation” on a routine basis against various disasters and the importance of “protection” in case of a disaster.

Bekotaro teaches important things.

The guide book was supervised by Michihiko Yanai, a creative director in Fukushima Prefecture and designed by Bunpei Yorifuji, a graphic designer, so that the book can be read by a variety of people ranging from children to elderly people.

People have to prepare well because Fukushima has the sea, mountains, and other things.

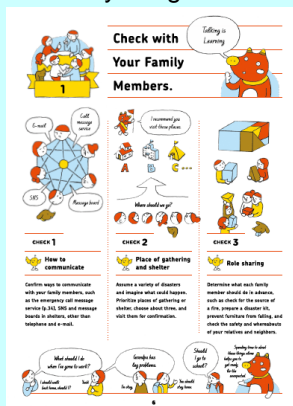
With that on my mind, I designed the book so that everyone can look at the pictures and easily understand the concept of disaster risk reduction.
